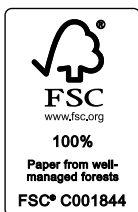
On-Product Usage

All FSC logos must be approved by appropriate certifier.

Categories of the FSC Label

1. **100%** for products containing 100% certified material.
2. **Mix** for products containing a combination of material from FSC certified forests, FSC controlled wood and eligible recycled fiber.
3. **Recycled** for products containing only recycled fiber.

Domtar products carry the FSC Mix label.

Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI®) Logo

General Information

There are two different types of SFI product labels depending on the source of the SFI fiber.

Certified Sourcing Label

The Certified Fiber Sourcing label means that the fiber is sourced from a company certified to SFI's fiber sourcing requirements, from pre or post-consumer recycled content, from non-controversial sources or from a certified forest.



Certified Chain-of-Custody (CoC)

The Chain-of-Custody label ensures the product includes certified fiber, which is tracked through production and manufacturing to the end product.

The primary mill must communicate the category of origin of certified forest content, post-consumer recycled material and certified sourcing fiber on the paperwork (packing list and invoice) and list the SFI Chain-of-Custody number.
