There, Domtar's fully integrated specialty paper mill has the capability of generating 100 percent of its electricity to produce a variety of publishing, specialty and security papers, as well as many functional coating base stocks such as thermal, point-of-sale receipt, carbonless, labels, poly base, repositioned notepad and saturating.
