MILL OVERVIEW

Located on the western side of spectacular coastal British Columbia, Howe Sound Pulp and Paper is one of the oldest operating mills in the province. Completely rebuilt to modern standards in 1991, generations of families who were first attracted to the area by mill jobs, stayed to make the Sunshine Coast their home. Howe Sound Pulp and Paper facility is a leading producer of high quality Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft pulps. These pulps are used by customers worldwide to make a variety of products from tissue and paper towels to fine writing paper.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- 90% of HSPP's energy comes from renewable sources with 50% reduction in greenhouse gases since 1990, Howe Sound power use is self-generated green electricity, 100% wood fibre is low risk using a risk assessment process and Strictest emission standards on the BC coast

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

The Howe Sound Mill has made donations to area food banks through supports provided to the local Salvation Army, St. Barts Food Bank, and the Sunshine Coast Community Services Society. Howe Sound provides funding to the Sunshine Coast Association for Community Living that supports people with developmental disabilities, the Sunshine Coast Search & Rescue, local Royal Canadian Legions and provided \$10,000 to Sunshine Coast School District 46 for an Indigenous Learning Program. Howe Sound also supported cultural events led by the Squamish Nation and supported museum and First Nation tours for the public and mill staff.
