MILL OVERVIEW

Established in 1883 and named after the Native American word for “swift running water,” Nekoosa is a small residential community located on the Wisconsin River. There, Domtar operates a fully integrated specialty paper mill that has the capability of generating 100 percent of its electricity to produce a variety of products, including FDA grades (FC-free oil & grease resistant, food packaging, and waxed grades for food contact), security and publishing grades, functional coating base stocks, and colors.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- More than 80 percent of the Nekoosa Mill’s manufacturing byproducts are beneficially reused and recycled.



COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

- Through longstanding agreements with the city, Domtar allows company-owned lands around the Nekoosa Mill to be used as recreational parks for public enjoyment.
