MILL OVERVIEW

The Domtar tissue mill in Sanford, FL, has the capability of producing a wide range of bath and towel for at-home and away-from-home markets, and is one of the few fully integrated tissue manufacturers in North America. The two tissue facilities in Florida have a combined annual production capacity of 62,000 short tons (56,000 metric tonnes) across three tissue machines and eight converting lines and offer virgin and recycled products in a range of grades.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- Our Florida tissue mills are certified to Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP, ISO-22716), Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI®) and Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®) chain-of-custody standards, in addition to being authorized to use the SFI Certified Sourcing label.
- The tissue mills participate in SolarTogether™, a shared solar program that is offered by Florida Power & Lighting (FPL) and projected to reduce annual greenhouse gas emissions by about 8,000 metric tonnes of CO₂ equivalent annually.

- Sanford employees completed 2024 without a single recordable injury, reaching 750,000 consecutive hours without a recordable injury. For every 250,000 injury-free hours, Domtar rewards employees with \$5,000 or more to donate to local organizations.
