MILL OVERVIEW

Cross City sawmill produces southern yellow pine dimensional lumber as well as radius edge decking used by construction industry in the Southeastern United States. The mill is well positioned for growth, in proximity to some of the markets with the highest population growth in the country.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- Since March 2022, Domtar's Cross City operations have sourced wood fiber and maintained chain-of-custody and fiber sourcing certificates under the standards of the sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI®), the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification™ (PEFC) and the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®). Third-party certification provides assurance that fiber-tracking systems are in place to identify the source of fiber or wood.



COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

- Cross City employees reached 250,000 consecutive hours without a recordable injury in 2023 and 2024. For every 250,000 injury-free hours, Domtar rewards employees with \$5,000 or more to donate to local organizations.
