MILL OVERVIEW

Located in the Eastern Townships Region of Quebec, Canada, Domtar's Windsor Mill is the last fully integrated fine paper mill in Canada. The mill manages 400,000 acres of private forest lands surrounding the mill. Originally built by Angus, Logan & Co. in 1864, the mill now produces bleached hardwood wet-lap market pulp and uncoated freesheet paper, including high-brightness opaques, multi-purpose digital papers copy paper, laser forms bond, envelope and recycled content. The mill is known for its innovative approach to sustainability. It leases the use of its forestlands for hunting, fishing and hiking clubs, as well as for maple syrup production.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- Through ecological donations totaling more than 12,000 acres, Domtar and the Windsor Mill have helped preserve some of Quebec's most prized forestlands, ensuring these unique ecosystems remain protected for future generations.
- Each year the Windsor Mill's forest team plants nearly 500,000 trees on Domtar's forest properties.
- The Windsor Mill has one of the lowest rates of water consumption in North America for a mill of its category.
- With its twin-generator cogeneration plant, the Windsor Mill produces nearly 50 MW of renewable energy equivalent to the annual consumption of 12,800 single-family homes.
- The Windsor Mill generates 90 percent of its energy from renewable resources and reuses more than 97 percent of its manufacturing byproducts.
