MILL OVERVIEW

The first paper roll was sold from the Alma Mill on December 12, 1925. For over a century, the mill has been a cornerstone of the local economy. For many people in Alma, it is not unusual for more than one generation of family members to have earned their livelihood at the Alma Mill.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- The mill captures and reuses waste steam to optimize boiler efficiency, cut thermal loss, and save 300,000 m³ of natural gas and 550 t of CO₂ annually.
- The mill recovers over 90% of its sludge (~50,000 t/year) and donates it to farmers to fertilize fields and improve soil quality.



COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

- The mill has invested over \$600,000 in the Alma community over the past 15 years, supporting initiatives such as Sac-à-DONS (which provides school supplies to children in need), La Moisson d'Alma (the local food bank), and \$325,000 donated to the Hotel Dieu D'Alma foundation as part of the waste recovery program.
