MILL OVERVIEW

The city of Dolbeau was founded when an American enterprise, Lake St. John Pulp & Paper Company, decided to build a paper mill on the Mistassibi River in 1926. In 2012, Domtar bought the idled Dolbeau Mill, invested over \$20 million, and restored its status as the main source of employment in the amalgamated town of Dolbeau-Mistassini. Today, the mill stands as a cornerstone of Dolbeau-Mistassini's economy and heritage, powering local prosperity through innovation and community commitment.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- At the Dolbeau Mill, the company improved its environmental performance by cutting bunker C oil use, reducing greenhouse gas emissions by about 1,600 metric tons of CO₂ equivalents per year.



COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

- The mill contributes upwards of \$9,000 per year to various organizations, such as OHS awards given to the community, over \$5,000 to local food drives, and the Wishing Tree organization, which provides support for disadvantaged children.
