## MILL OVERVIEW

Recognized as one of the most technologically advanced paper mills in the world, Domtar's Johnsonburg Mill in Pennsylvania boasts a long and rich history of papermaking since its operations began in 1888. Located near the Allegheny National Forest on the headwaters of the Clarion River, the mill manufactures uncoated freesheet papers used by customers to create brochures, direct mail, stationery, checks, envelopes and hardbound books



## ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- For nearly 30 years, the Johnsonburg Mill has raised rainbow and brown trout fingerlings inside the mill, releasing approximately 13,000 of them each year to local waterways.
- The Johnsonburg Mill plays a significant role in rehabilitating local land scarred by decades of coal mining by using manufacturing byproducts to amend the soil, making the land and stream attractive to wildlife again.



## COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

- Each year the Johnsonburg Mill contributes about \$60,500 in grassroots giving to the local community.
