MILL OVERVIEW

Opened in 1916, Domtar's Kingsport Mill in Tennessee is a downtown landmark with an ideal industrial location on the South Fork Holston River. In January 2023, the mill officially became Domtar's first 100 percent recycled containerboard facility manufacturing linerboard for corrugated boxes. The mill is home to the second-largest recycled containerboard machine in North America and showcases cutting-edge technology.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- The Kingsport Mill is the largest recycler of old corrugated container (OCC) in the state of Tennessee.
- Each year, the mill will use about 660,000 tons of recovered paper to produce new recycled packaging products to serve independent corrugated converters.
