MILL OVERVIEW

Opened in 1978, Domtar's Saint-Félicien Market Pulp is a leading producer of Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft (NBSK) market pulp. The mill was acquired by Domtar in 2012, and today supplies high-quality softwood pulp for tissue, packaging and hygiene products worldwide. The mill employs 265 people and is part of a network of Domtar mills in the Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean region that provides more than 2,000 total jobs in the region, making it an important local economic contributor.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- The Saint-Félicien Market Pulp Mill deploys an industry-first enzyme-enabled carbon capture technology that reduces energy waste by cutting thermal losses and delivers annual savings of 2.4 million m³ of natural gas, 970,000 litres of oil, and 7,500 metric tons of CO₂.

- The Saint-Félicien Mill contributes to the local community through donations to health and mental wellness support groups, a speed skating team, a daycare, and a mutual aid organization, and has hosted more than 45 professional, college, and university interns.
